22 Bridges Constructed for New US 264 Bypass

The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) hired the Barnhill Contracting Company Design-Build team to construct 12.6 miles of the new US 264 bypass in Pitt County. Designed by HDR, SCI served as the structure lead and completed 22 bridges.



NCDOT extended US 264 through means of a four-lane divided highway to improve connectivity from Greenville to Ayden. SCI was part of the team who priced, designed, and completed construction of the bypass. This project totaled 3,230 LF of structures.

Consistent communication helped the Team meet its goal of delivering a quality project to the citizens of North Carolina in a timely manner. The Team delivered the project to NCDOT 200 days early.
