Final Bridge Package Completed for I-295 Outer Loop

After the award-winning completion of a 3.2-mile section of I-295, Sanford Contractors was selected by Branch Civil to lead bridge construction for the final segment of the Fayetteville Outer Loop, from south of Camden Road to south of US 401.



This bridge package was one of the most complex Sanford Contractors has completed, spanning five job sites and featuring two of the widest bridge decks in company history—Camden Road at 117 feet wide and Strickland Bridge at 140 feet wide.

Facing an aggressive schedule, the team successfully balanced resources, personnel, and equipment across multiple active projects to keep each phase moving efficiently. Through careful planning, disciplined management, and strong collaboration, Sanford Contractors delivered the completed bridge package several months ahead of schedule and within budget.

Completion of this section marks a major milestone in the long-anticipated I-295 Outer Loop—an effort decades in the making. First envisioned in the late 1980s and under construction for more than 25 years, Sanford Contractors is proud to have contributed to the bridge work, helping bring this regional project closer to completion.
